It's a race against time to build the ramp of the hangar. The river is rising more than 2 feet per day. Even so, the barges are still unable to arrive. Without diesel, the city continues to ration electricity several hours a day. We are praying that God will help us finish the ramp this year so we can transfer the airplane, do maintenance on the airplane and mission boats and use it for the honor and glory of God!



Life here is anything but what you would consider “normal”. For this young woman, an average, ordinary day means selling her cucumbers at the port with her baby by her side. Can you see him fast asleep, nestled in the plastic tub on the bottom right hand corner? May God use us to help these people find true joy in Jesus!



Besides our mission trips and ministries in the interior of the Amazon, Wilson and I are going full force ahead in our local church as well. I am teaching the adolescent class and the children’s worship time during the Sunday evening services. Wilson continues to teach the adults Sunday school class, preach and disciple leaders during the week. We both have substitutes to carry on when we are in river villages.
