Wilson and I want to thank you for praying for us and the ministries throughout the Amazon. Please pray with us that as we face this new year God will help us to:

- *Solidify the "Adopt a Pastor" website and a few other details so we can send regular updates and pictures of the pastors being supported. Also, that He would raise up Christians to help provide support for pastors ministering in remote river communities throughout the Amazon.*
- *Continue to solidify and support our existing church plants, providing direction, seminary training and visits to encourage these pastors and leaders throughout the year.*
- *Continue training and discipling children's ministry workers through teacher-training courses and workshops. (My goal for this year is to teach a new workshop that teaches children all about prayer and how to pray. It's called "Talking to God" and is divided into three separate seminars and includes five complete lesson plans on prayer and visuals the teachers will make for use with these lessons.)*
- *Trust God to establish new churches in remote villages where there are none.*
- *Know who should receive and would make good use of the Sunday School Kits I have put together for children's ministry workers in remote villages. These kits include*

teacher's manuals, student's handbooks and visuals and provides all the resources teacher's need to teach God's Word to children for up to three years.

- *Find a viable way to LOAN materials from the Resource Library I have set up at our house which includes resources such as Sunday School Kits, puppets, visuals, lessons and materials for special events and parties, etc. Many of these materials will need to be loaned for up to 3 months at a time and culturally, people don't often return what they loan.*
