CAVALO COCHA, PERU

Two days after we arrived in Benjamin Constant, Wilson went to Cavalo Cocha, Peru by boat to check on two new churches being constructed; one on the other side of the city from the first church that we planted and another one in a nearby village called **Paulo Seco**. The Leadership Training Center is located on the other side of the street from this church.

The wood for these two churches and for the dormitory of the conference center in Cavalo Cocha was cut from chain saws that were donated for this purpose. We are able to economize 40% on church construction because of this awesome gift!

Wilson shared a message with the youth group on Saturday night and gave the message at the original church plant on Sunday night.



IQUITOS, PERU Wilson went to Iquitos for one week to work on the documents to legalize the Peruvian church plants and oversee the construction of a new church in one of the poorer areas. Together with Pr. Edgardo they bought the wood, metal rods, cement and sand and had it delivered to the construction site.



Wilson was thrilled to find a used cement mixer to speed up their work. He also purchased a pump to drain water from the construction site since this area often floods during rainy season (which is just beginning). **You may be wondering why not build the church somewhere else?!** Because this is where a LOT of people live, and they don't have a place to hear about God's love and salvation through Christ!



Pr. Reojildo and his wife **Carmen** live next to the church and have already been holding worship services in their home. They are a dedicated couple and are grateful to the Lord to have us join with them as ministry partners, helping to build the church, making visits from time to time, providing leadership training, and preaching. Wilson gave the message in two services during the week and preached in Cavalo Cocha one evening on his trip home.





When **Pr. Marciel** and **Glória** left Santa Luzia, they stayed a few months in Iquitos. God allowed Glória to spend time with three of her sisters before COVID claimed their lives. They are very excited to be moving to a river village called **Indiana**, where one of their daughters lives, to begin a new church plant. **Indiana** is located along the same river where Nate Saint and four other missionaries were martyred.

WE PRAISE GOD FOR YOUR PARTNERSHIP!

Through your prayers and partnership these past two years, God has moved, and ministries have expanded. We administered several Leadership Training Conferences in river villages and Indian tribes in Brazil and in Peru, and I (Lori) held my 1st teacher training course in an indigenous area. With God's direction, I was able to finish 37 more Sunday School kits and several more series of Children's Bible Lesson Plans and activities. Now we are preparing to distribute them to the church plants and provide orientation on their use.

There are three new churches being founded, one in Cavalo Cocha another in Paulo Seco and the other in Iquitos, Peru. At the mission base, the marina for the mission boats is already in use and the hospitality apartment is almost completely built. The plane received a new coat of paint, and the mission boats received much needed maintenance and a new tarp roof for one of the smaller boats. We are ready and excited to begin receiving mission teams once again!

We have also finally launched the website: familywithoutbordersint.org containing pictures and information of the pastors of the church plants in remote river communities. This site allows others to support the ministries of needy pastors and provide a way to send funds for ministry projects.

CHANGING TIMES: There have been some unforeseen changes these past two years as well. Two of our supporting churches have stopped sending funds. One was due to the pandemic, and another had a change in their mission vision. Another church was forced to cut our support in half for some of the same reasons. God also called several of our dear ministry partners home. Through the years, we haven't made a point of mentioning any personal monthly support needs. God has ALWAYS provided, and we know He will continue to do so. However, after a time of consideration and prayer, we felt led to ask for your specific prayers about this. Our current support needs amount to a little over \$1,000.00. We praise God for your faithful giving month after month, year after year and know most of you are giving all you can, but we cherish your prayers for new ministry partners and supporting churches! It will be exciting to see God at work. 😊
