Ministry Trip to Iquitos, Peru *December 2023*

There are three church plants in Iquitos. The first night Wilson preached at the newest church plant, led by Pr. Washington. The second night, he preached in Pr. Reogildo's church (no picture), and the third night was Pr. Wilson's church. At the end of that service, a woman, who was visiting, walked to the front seeking reconciliation with God. Wilson hadn't even given any kind of altar call, but God touched her heart and she obeyed. Wilson was able to visit a few homes in the afternoons, sharing God's Word and praying together as well. It was so precious! God poured out tremendous blessings in each place, surprising Wilson with powerful times of praise and worship, moments of forgiveness and reconciliation between church leaders and amazingly uplifting meetings.

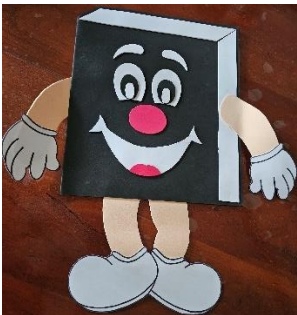


Party Kits for Children's Events at Churches
