**Arequipa, Peru** God called **Pr. Dennis** to join our non-profit organization: **Family Without Borders Intl.** three years ago. He started a church plant in the Andes mountains in **Arequipa, Peru** and has also been ministering to a community higher up in the mountains for a year now.
