While Wilson was travelling, I (Lori) updated the menu and shopping list for boat trips and shopped for three mission trips from a Baptist Church in Texas, sponsored by Pastor Stan. He has his own translators, but our team is responsible for cleaning the boat, washing hammocks, blankets, and mosquito nets, hiring cooks and crew and purchasing food and supplies for each trip. There have been four 7-day boat/mission trips in the last two months. I also enjoyed working on ministry projects and catching up on correspondence.

The pastor of the church in Vera Cruz sent this picture to show how excited and thankful they are to already be using the Sunday School curriculum I sent after our trip there with the mission team from Coastal Church in VA. What a JOY to know the children in this village are learning to know God and make Him known!



You cannot imagine how God uses your prayers to transform lives here and build us up! Our guys get tired. Wilson said one night a rooster under the pastor's house where they stayed kept them up all night. It is unbearably hot at times, making it impossible to rest in the hammocks with no fans to help. Wilson often swings his hammock to get a little breeze! Villages are far, spread out, and sometimes hard to reach. It's a wonderful blessing, encouraging, and spending time connecting with leaders and church members. Thank you for upholding us in prayer, loving us, and serving together with us to make disciples of all nations!
